Message to Families

Dear 911 Driving School Families,

We know the news of the coronavirus (COVID-19) has created a level of concern in our community and we want to assure you that the health of our students and staff is our top priority.

As we have communicated, we are following the most up-to-date recommendations from our local government and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) on hygiene and sanitation practices:

- Objects and surfaces that are touched by students and school staff (tables, counters, steering wheels, seatbelts, doorknobs, toilets, phones, etc.) are frequently cleaned.
- Employees showing cold or flu-like symptoms are not allowed in the facility or in cars.
- Alcohol-based hand sanitizer is readily available for use.

Currently, our behind-the-wheel driving lessons are continuing. As this may change due to new restrictions being imposed in the coming hours and days, please keep in close contact with us and remain on e-mail and the web as we will be sharing updates.

If your child is sick, please reschedule behind-the-wheel driving lessons.

According to the CDC and Department of Health, COVID-19 primarily spreads through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person sneezes or coughs. Currently, the best measure to avoid COVID-19 is to avoid coming in contact with the virus through the following personal hygiene measures:

- Wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains 60- 95% alcohol when water and soap are not available.
- Avoid touching your eyes, mouth and nose with unwashed hands.
- Stay home if sick.
- Cover your nose and mouth when coughing or sneezing with a tissue, and immediately dispose of the tissue and wash your hands for at least 20 seconds.

This is a challenging time for everyone, and we are keeping those who have been directly impacted in our thoughts. These times are unprecedented, but we are doing everything we can to get through them together.
