911 Driving School of Kirkland Adult Lesson Policies

Adult lessons are conducted behind-the-wheel in 60-minute sessions in our vehicles.

The DOL Knowledge Test and Road Tests are a separate charge. All lessons must be prepaid in full. We take most major credit and debit cards.

You must have a valid WA permit or current license from another state or country on your person for all lessons. We cannot allow you to drive without one.

We offer lessons 7 days per week, at all different times during the day. Availability varies according to Instructor schedules; however, we will work with you to schedule the most convenient times. We frequently schedule with different Instructors, so please let us know if you prefer to work with the same person. Every individual is different, and people learn at different speeds. Your Instructor will do a skills assessment during your first lesson, and he/she will be able to estimate the number of lessons needed at that time.

CANCELLATION POLICY: Any cancellations or schedule changes must be arranged no later than 24 hours before the scheduled lesson. Missed lessons or cancellations less than 24 hours before the lesson will result in a \$50 missed drive fee. Showing up for a lesson without a valid license or permit will result in a \$50 missed drive fee. If you arrive late for a lesson, the length of your lesson will be reduced accordingly. All instructional vehicles are equipped with video cameras for safety and training purposes only. Images from the cameras will never be used for public display of any type and are not available for viewing.
