

Marysville 911 Driving School Adult Driving Policies

1. There are no refunds for the private drives or private drive packages.
2. Private drives are conducted in 60-minute increments in our vehicle.
3. Every individual learns at a different pace. On your first drive the instructor will assess your skills and discuss with you how many drives are recommended. You will need to get additional practice at home for the best results.
4. Taking a private drive or a package of them does not guarantee you will pass the Washington State skills (road) test.
5. Drives are scheduled by you at dates and times that work for your schedule and are available on our calendar. We do not guarantee any specific dates or times will be available until they are scheduled.
6. On occasion instructors may become unavailable and a drive will have to be cancelled and rescheduled.
7. If you cancel a drive with less than 24 hours' notice you will be charged a fee, or you can choose to forfeit the drive. We understand that issues and incidents happen, **but we do not waive this fee.**
8. When arriving for a drive you must have your permit with you and provide it to your instructor. If you do not bring your permit to a drive your lesson will be cancelled, and you will be charged a fee to reschedule or you can forfeit the drive.
9. If you are late to your drive you will forfeit the time you are late and have a shorter drive. Please schedule accordingly. Alternatively, you can pay a rescheduling fee and do the drive on another day.
10. You cannot wear flip flops, heels, open-toed shoes, sandals that are not fully enclosed or slippers for any drive. If you do not have something appropriate to change into your drive will be cancelled, and you will be charged a fee to reschedule or you can choose to forfeit the drive.
