Behind the Wheel (BTW) Practice: Students are eligible to start behind the wheel instruction after completing their first day of classroom instruction. In addition to course drives with instructors, 50 hours of supervised driving (a minimum of 40 hours during the day and 10 hounight) is required by Washington State prior to receiving a driver license. If parents are unable, or refuse, to practice with the student and student is not able to complete the tasks of each BTW lesson, parents will need to purchase additional drives at the rate of \$60.00 per houf or the student to move onto the next drive lesson.
