Adult Student Driving Lesson Options

Adult drive lessons purchased by the Hour: Consists of one-on-one driving instruction with a certified driving instructor in hourly increments, with a maximum of one hour driving instruction per day.

Adult drive package: Consists of (5) one-hour sessions of one-on-one driving instruction with a certified driving instructor. This package also includes one Knowledge Test and one Drive Test.

NOTE: Completion of this traffic safety instruction does not guarantee students will pass the DOL drive test.

School Policies

A valid driver's permit is required for instructional drives.

Vehicle Use: A TC911 instructional vehicle will be used for driving lessons and drive tests.

Note: Adult students need to complete their services in a timely manner. To maintain compliance with this, it is our school policy that all services must be completed within one year from date of purchase.

Payment Options: We accept Master Card, Visa, Cash, and Money Orders for payments. We do not accept personal checks, Discover, or American Express as a form of payment. Full payment is expected at the time of registration.

Additional Fees: The student account will be charged \$60.00 for not being prepared to drive, i.e. not having a permit or not having proper footwear, etc., or for cancelling drives with less than 24-hour notice.

Refunds: Partial refunds (payments made minus a \$50.00 administration fee) will be given before the first component of the service has been rendered if requested within one month of the date of purchase. No refunds will be given after one month or for failure to complete the course.
